

Transcript of Daniella Rivera and James Albino

DR: This is Daniella Rivera with AIDS.gov and a speaker from the White House presented at the National Latino AIDS Awareness Day Congressional Briefing this afternoon. Will you please state your name and title?

JA: My name is James Albino. I'm a senior program manager for the Office of National AIDS Policy.

DR: And what were your two – what were the two points from the White House today, at today's Congressional Briefing?

JA: Certainly, There were actually three key points, and those were the points President Obama outlined. One is his commitment to work on a national AIDS strategy that reduces the level of incidence that is focused on prevention and provides a channel for access to care.
